

Nance Scholarship Fund Selection Criteria

To qualify for a Nance Scholarship, applicants must submit the following:

1. A copy of your most current transcript.
2. A brief written statement describing your interest, motivation and determination to pursue education and/or training beyond high school, including instances where you demonstrated leadership abilities. (Please use a separate piece of paper and limit your answer to approximately 100 words)
3. Supply ACT/SAT scores plus high school class rank.
4. At least one letter of recommendation.
5. A grade point average of 2.0 or better is required.

APPLICATION MUST BE TYPED OR PRINTED LEGIBLY IN BLACK OR BLUE INK.

It is important that the application packet be returned as soon as possible. Application packets must be postmarked by January 31, 2018.

APPLICATIONS RECEIVED WITH A POSTMARK AFTER JANUARY 31, 2018, WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.
